The area beyond the bushes is cleared and the goals are stored in that space.

A clearing is made within the bushes and so we can carry them in and out using existing gate

A private fence (if required) is erected beyond the bushes and a 2nd gate is placed at the bottom of the park, so we can carry them in and out without having any impact on the car parking

OPTION 3

If not possible to clear the area beyond the bushes, then either of the two areas marked in red and we will store the goals in the most economical space we possibly can

GOALS

The area of the car park space is approximately 102 metres deep by 21 metres wide.
 Around 75 metres down there is a significant change on the appearance of the layout.
 Whereas the top half is clear (with the exception of the foliage around the perimeter), the bottom half beyond the bushes has trees and is severely overgrown.

It is the opinion that we have so much wasted space beyond the bushes and potentially a lot of space that could be used for parking or equipment storage.

It is very very kind of the Parish Council to allow us to use the area for the storage of our goals. The goals have been purchased with our own fund raising events and efforts over the last 3-5 years and there is an estimated value of £25k worth.
 Without that area of storage, our goals would be very vulnerable and we would run a very high security risk from theft and/or vandalism.

It is so important for the football club to keep them stored behind lock and key, so we would kindly request that we keep them stored within. We feel there is so much space in the car park, and the area can work as a dual purpose of car parking and our goal storage.

We would store the goals in the most 'economical space' saving way and do a 'Russin Doll' effect where possible, so as many cars as possible can fit in, around.

The area at the bottom beyond the bushes, if it can be cleared and privately fenced, would be perfect and we can either take the goals up and out the existing gate, or alternatively, if it can be arranged to add a 2nd entrance gate to the bottom of the area, so facing out in to the park, that would also be fine.

Or if that is not possible a marked out area within the comound and above the bushes covering the overall area size of all the goals.
