ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82, 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

REVOCATION, MODIFICATION AND AMENDMENTS

The "Kent County Council (Various Roads, The Borough of Tonbridge & Malling) (20mph, 30mph, 40mph, 50mph Speed Limits and Derestricted Roads) Consolidation Order 2012" ('the Order of 2012') be amended as follows.

In Schedule 4 of the Order of 2012 the following entry in the Table below shall be added to the Schedule.

AMENDMENT NO.43 ORDER 2021

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82, 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

The effect of the Order would be to change the national speed limit to 40MPH speed limit on the following length of road, in Tonbridge:

A26 TONBRIDGE ROAD, WATERINGBURY – From a point in line with the western boundary of 448 Tonbridge Road to a point in 18 metres west of Pizien Well Road.

The Order was made on 1 September 2022 and its provisions will come into effect on 2 September 2022.

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement to the Orders.
